Add the descriptor "special issue of" and include the name of the journal, also in italics, followed by the rest of the information required for a standard scholarly journal citation.

Here are the components of a scholarly article in MLA style (if you don't have one of the components, leave it out):  
Author(s). "Title of Article." Title of Journal, Volume, Issue, Year, pages. URL or DOI Cite the online database, if relevant, by name in italics before the URL (i.e. Academic Search Premier). For articles you found in print, you don't need to include online access information.

## **APA Style: Citing articles**

An Article in an Online Scholarly Journal. For all online scholarly journals, provide the author(s) name(s), the name of the article in quotation marks, the title of the publication in italics, all volume and issue numbers, and the year of publication. Include a DOI if available, otherwise provide a URL or permalink to help readers locate the source.

Start your reference page citation with the last name of the first author followed by a comma, followed by the author's capitalized first initial and a period. Then

Scholarly sources (also referred to as academic, peer-reviewed, or refereed sources) are written by experts in a particular field and serve to keep others interested in that field up to date on the most recent research, findings, and news.

## **Determine If a Source Is Scholarly - Undergraduate Library ...**

The source information required in a parenthetical citation depends (1) upon the source medium (e.g. print, web, DVD) and (2) upon the source's entry on the Works Cited page. Any source information that you provide in-text must correspond to the source information on the Works Cited page.

## **Scholarly Journal Articles - Citation Guide - LibGuides at ...**

In-Text Citation of a Direct Quote or Statistic. Place the citation after the quote and cite the author's last name, publication year and the page number where the quote can be found in the journal as follows: (Haley, 2008, p. 232). Do not write out "page" for the page number; use "p." instead. Always put a comma in between the year and the page number.
