The IRS issues most refunds in less than 21 days, although some require additional time. You should only call if it has been: 21 days or more since you e-filed. 6 weeks or more since you mailed your return, or when.

Extension to File Your Tax Return. If you can't file your federal income tax return by the due date, you may be able to get a six-month extension from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS). This does not grant you more time to pay your taxes.

If you were expecting a federal tax refund and did not receive it, check the IRS' Where's My Refund page. You'll need to enter your Social Security number, filing status, and the exact whole dollar amount of your refund. You may be prompted to change your address online.

When you mail a tax return, you need to attach any documents showing tax withheld, such as your W-2's or any 1099's. Use a mailing service that will track it, such as UPS or certified mail so you will know the IRS received the return.

A tax lien is a legal claim to your assets. For instance, if you have a car loan, the lender has a lien against your vehicle. When the IRS files a Notice of Federal Tax Lien, that alerts creditors that the IRS has a legal claim against your property. At this point, the IRS is not taking your property yet.
